

2013 Parade Rules and Regulations

Entrants are required to attend a “Safety Meeting” 7:00 pm on Thursday March 7, 2013. The meeting will be held at the American Legion Goff-Moll Post 101 at 2721 Collier Ave, Brentwood, Mo. The parade packet pick-up will be held at the conclusion of the meeting. Failure to attend this meeting will result in termination of your parade participation.

Absolutely no political/commercial advertising of any kind will be allowed.

Follow the instructions of the parade marshals. They are present for your protection and are empowered to remove any group/float from the parade

The mustering area will be opened at 9:00 am. Large motorized units (vehicles with trailers, large trucks, etc.) must be in position by 10:30 am. Smaller motorized units (cars, Pick-ups, etc.) must be in position by 11:00 am. Marching units should be in position by 12:00. The mustering area must be left clean and litter free.

Non-participating vehicles may enter the mustering area between 9:00 and 10:30 am to drop off people and /or supplies. These vehicles must be marked with the position number and must exit the area as soon as they have finished unloading. The mustering area will closed to these vehicles at 10:30 am.

As mandated by the police, all participants must wear a button provided by the parade committee.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited during the parade. Dispose of all cans and bottles before the start of the march.

Each vehicle must provide “wheel guards” (two per van/auto, four per truck/trailer).

Throwing candy, beads, etc. from a vehicle/float is prohibited. Such items can only be handed out by people walking along the curb.

Any portable toilets on a float must be camouflaged.

All units are to maintain the pace set by the lead unit and keep a distance of 30 feet between units. If a parade marshal instructs you to speed up or slow down, please do so. Do not stop during the parade

The parade will end at Manchester Ave. Please make arrangements for your unit to disperse without stopping to pickup or discharge passengers. Do not stop on Manchester.

This is a family orientated parade. Please keep it that way!
