Clan na Gael Award 2010 Irish Person of the Year Dennis Reagan

Denny Reagan is President and CEO of The Muny in St. Louis. Before being named President in 1991, Denny had advanced through the ranks of the outdoor theatre by working as a member of the clean-up team, wardrobe dresser, member of the stage crew, runner/courier, office clerk, office manager, Manager of Theatre Operations and Assistant General Manager. Denny attended Bishop DuBourg High School and received a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from University of Missouri – St. Louis.

With 11,000 seats, The Muny, located in Forest Park, is the world's largest outdoor musical theatre. Each summer from mid-June through mid-August, The Muny produces ageless and contemporary Broadway shows starring some of the best beloved performers from Broadway, film and television. The 2011 summer season will celebrate The Muny's 93rd season in Forest Park.

In addition to his work for The Muny, Mr. Reagan is actively involved with a number of local and national arts, civic and academic institutions. He served as president of the National Alliance for Musical Theatre, an associate member of the Broadway League and a board member of the Professional Theatre Awards Council and the Atlanta Theatre of the Stars. He is a board member of the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society and also serves on the boards of the Central Institute for the Deaf and Bishop DuBourg High School. He is a member of the Chancellor's Council of the University of Missouri St. Louis and Commissioner of the Regional Arts Commission (RAC), the area's largest annual funder of the arts, dedicated to the cultivation, promotion and fostering of cultural programming in the St. Louis region.

A native of St. Louis, Denny Reagan and his wife Michelle reside in South St. Louis County. They have three children – John, Maggie and Amy.

Ancient Order of Hibernians Honor Guard

As part of the steep Irish Catholic and patriotic tradition of the Ancient Order of Hibernians an Honor Guard was established. This unit is comprised of volunteer members who take time out of their busy schedules, like all Hibernians do, to represent the Ancient Order of Hibernians at many events. Dave Gallagher**

Dave attended St. Jude the Apostle School where he was taught by the Sisters of St. Joseph. His Fourth grade teacher an elderly nun from Ireland always referred to Dave by the name of "Clarence O'Rourke" because she said he looked like a boy from her childhood. During that entire year he went by the name Clarence O'Rourke. Dave joined the Cardinal Glennon Division of AOH in 1994. He has served his Division as Financial Secretary, Treasurer, President and Historian. He has served the County Board as a two term President and has been a member of the State Board. He serves on the St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee as Treasurer and is the current Chairman of the annual Irish Country Fair. Dave has played the guitar in local bands since the mid 1960's but in 1995 he was inspired by fellow Hibernian Dave Holmes to play the bagpipes. Holmes helped him get a set of pipes and he began learning to play from the legendary Pete Sullivan a native of County Kerry. Pete was not only a fellow Hibernian member but also a fellow parishioner at St. Gregory the Great (now called Holy Trinity Parish) in St. Ann. Dave enjoys being a piper with the Hibernians and today plays for many Irish weddings and funerals as well as the annual Easter Rising of 1916 ceremony at Calvary Cemetery. He has enjoyed performing with Hibernian Pipers Dave Holmes, Jay Ryan and bass drummer Dennis Sullivan. He is also a member of the Missouri Karate Association. He began his training in the mid 1970's with JKA Shotokan Karate and has also trained in Aikido, Shindo Muso Ryu Jodo and Kendo but only does Karate today. Dave and his wife Barb were married in 1972 at his childhood parish of St. Jude. Their daughter Erin Kathleen, now married to former Irish dancer Chris Schott, was born in 1985 and is a dancer with the O'Faolain Academy of Irish Dance.

Dave and his wife Barb live in St. Ann and are members of Holy Trinity parish.

Special Achievement Award to Past National AOH President George J. Clough, Jr.

Brother George J. Clough, Jr. has been a Hibernian for over 40 years, during which time he has served in many positions on the National Board of the Ancient Order of Hibernians. He was elected to two terms as National President joining Brother Jack Keane as one of only four people west of the Mississippi elected to be President in the 175 year history of the Order. While President he visited Northern Ireland many times and marched in the “Bloody Sunday” commemoration in Derry City. On his trips to Northern Ireland he visited the Political Prisoners in the Maze (Long Kesh) prison and delivered the proceeds of the Annual Christmas Appeal Fund to Jerry Adams and Martin McGuinness at receptions held at the AOH Hall in Derry City. He Chaired the 1978 National Convention in Killarney, Ireland. He served for 17 years as Chairman of the Notre Dame-Hibernian Fund. The Fund currently contains over \$2,000,000 and has awarded \$800,000 in scholarship assistance to members and sons and daughters of members of the AOH and LAOH. While President he was involved in working with Cardinal O’Connor and the AOH attorneys in saving the New York St. Patrick’s Day Parade from being disturbed by a group from the Irish Gay and Lesbian Organization. The AOH won the Court cases in both the New York Federal and the United States Supreme Court. He presently serves as National Legal Counsel and with two other Past National Presidents as a member of the Oversight Committee that reviews all the investment and financial activities of the Order and makes a quarterly report to the National Board. George was instrumental in the St. Louis AOH bid to attract the 2014 National Convention in St. Louis, an event he looks forward to while admitting he is glad that someone else is the chairman!

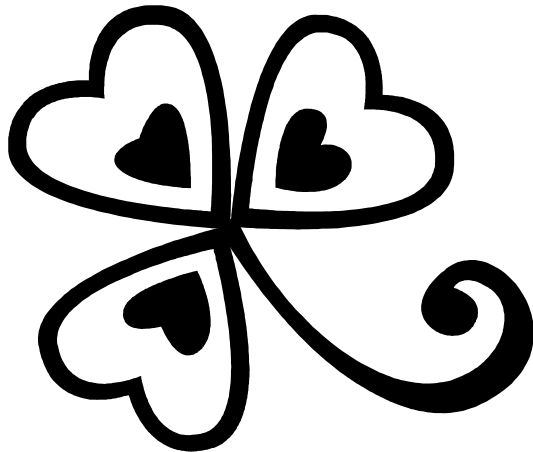

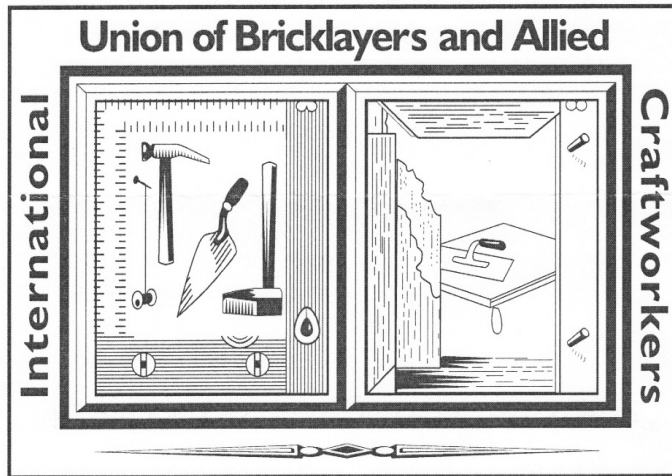

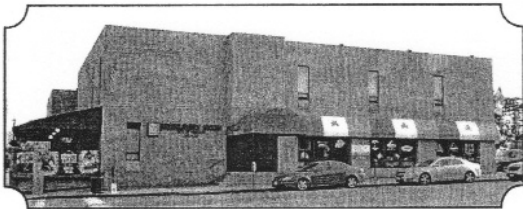

CLAN na GAEL

Clan na Gael can be translated as “Family of Ireland” or “Children of Ireland” but in the American context Clan na Gael can only refer to the longest standing Irish-American revolutionary organization

Clan na Gael was founded in New York in 1867 and still exists today, though much diminished. In 1877 it affiliated with the Irish Republican Brotherhood, which it recognized as the legitimate provisional government of Ireland. With over 250,000 American members at its peak it sustained the struggle in Ireland throughout its history.

Among its notable efforts were financial successes such as financing the *Catalpa* Affair, Holland’s first successful submarine, the *Fenian Ram* and the German arms used in the Easter Rising 1916.

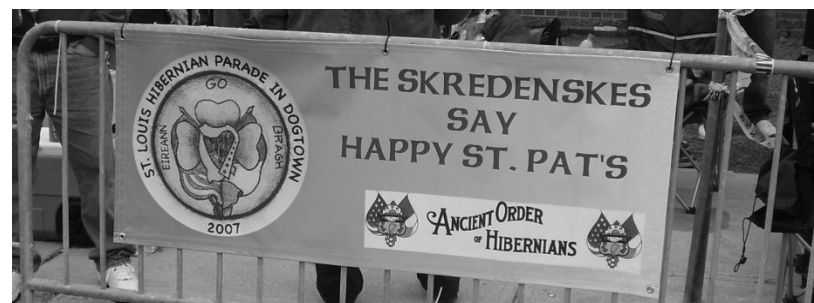
